

I give my child or ward permission to attend Euroventure. I have read the rules and realize that if he/she behaves in an unacceptable manner, dismissal at my expense might result. I have reviewed these rules with my child or ward and he/she agrees to abide by them.

1. Students must attend all sessions. Late arrivals to, early departures from or other activities/meetings during Euroventure are not permitted for anyone for any length of time. Every student is required to attend every session.
2. Students must go straight to their meeting places.
3. Students must be in the bunks and have lights out at the assigned times. Breaking curfew at Euroventure is unacceptable for anyone – including adults.
4. Drugs, alcohol, any form of tobacco, firearms, weapons, or any fireworks are not permitted. Students possessing these at Euroventure will have their parents contacted and may be sent home at the discretion of the camp leadership.
5. Electronic entertainment devices are not allowed to be used during the week. They will be confiscated and NOT returned until the end of the week. If a student brings them with their youth leaders' approval for travel purposes, we will ask the youth leaders to collect them and lock them up for the week.
6. Students must dress appropriately, inside and outside of the pool. Modest one piece bathing suits only please.
7. Any form of Public or Private Display of Affection (PDA) is not allowed.
8. Under NO circumstances are girls to be near or in the guys' barracks or vice versa.
9. Students who are injured or ill should contact the IBC Staff or an adult sponsor immediately. Do not remain in your room. The emergency care person is responsible for diagnosing illness, not your roommate.
10. Churches are responsible for damage to campus/facilities. Because the Downtown Lodge holds the IBC Staff responsible for all damages, any damage or loss will be the responsibility of the churches involved. If no admission of guilt is made regarding room damage, each party in the room will be billed an equal portion of the cost of repair by the church. A letter/bill will be sent following Euroventure.

I give permission that my child's or ward's photo or video may be taken for the IBC website, social media, and/or publication. Should I not wish his/her photo to be published, I will have my child or ward notify his/her adult sponsor as well as identify himself/herself to the registration desk at check-in on Saturday.

My child or ward has my permission to be in all Euroventure activities at the place named herein and on the dates named herein, except as noted by me. If a medical emergency should arise while my child or ward is at Euroventure or in transit to Euroventure and I cannot be reached, I consent and give my permission to the trip director or representative of Euroventure

to select a physician and/or hospital for my child's or ward's care. I also give the physician and/or hospital, as selected by the trip director or representative of Euroventure, my permission to hospitalize, treat, give x-rays, tests and to order injections, anesthesia, or surgery for my child or ward, which may be in their sole discretion under the circumstances. I do release, acquit, discharge and covenant to hold harmless the church, the International Baptist Convention, its representatives, the trip director or Euroventure staff, of any and all actions, damages, or liabilities arising out of the treatment of any sickness or accident incurred by my child or ward to disclose any information there acquired, if requested. I understand that in the event of a medical emergency requiring medical care, all costs for such emergency care ARE MY RESPONSIBILITY and I agree to make payment of all such medical costs. I understand that I will be notified of medical care, and that I must notify my insurance carrier.

RAFTING PERMISSION (applicable only to those who have paid for the rafting)

I understand that there is a risk involved when rafting, and I hereby give permission to the staff of Euroventure and the guides of the rafting company to authorize treatment of any required emergency medical procedures for him/her, if the need should arise. I have talked to my student about safety and the importance of following the instructions of the guides.
