Cutting edge and rich in history, Stockholm is the capital of Sweden and the most populous city in the Nordic countries; approximately 4.5 million in the total metropolitan area. The city stretches across fourteen islands where Lake Mälaren flows into the Baltic Sea. Stockholm is the cultural, media, political, and economic center of Sweden. The city is home to some of Europe's top ranking universities. The vast majority of the population under 40 years of age speak English. There is a tremendous opportunity for a new English-speaking church in Stockholm.
