Student Ministry Associate Position

Background/History: AIC was founded in 1969 and has served the English speaking expatriate community for 50 years. Our congregational average weekly attendance is 100-110 adults with max capacity available of 150 adults. We are a mix of expat NGO, kingdom workers, embassy staff, language students, domestic laborers and national's representing about 20 distinct ethnic/language people groups. We have a vibrant youth group of 60-70. We meet on Saturday evenings in the auditorium of The Amman Baptist School. Job Summary: The Student Ministry Associate of Amman International Church (AIC) will function full-time (10 month) in a dual role to lead weekly corporate music ministry, students ministry (teaching/music) and be an extension of the overall AIC shepherding model on behalf of the Sr. Pastor and Elders. Ideally, the Student Ministry leader will need to have a keen awareness and sensitivity of the nature of expat, international church communities including the transient nature of the congregation (high turnover, etc.) as well as wise relationships with parents of students, 3rd culture issues, school administration and national's.

Qualifications: The Student Ministry leader must be humble, of mature character and meet the moral, ethical and biblical competency qualifications in 1 Timothy 3 and Titus 1. He must be able to handle the word of God accurately in teaching and counseling. The Student Ministry leader must be willing to honor AIC's musical heritage, which consists of theologically sound hymns and contemporary songs and must be willing to work with and honor current volunteers for their long lasting service to AIC. In addition, he must have knowledge and ability to work and manage musical and tech gear necessary to run a service as well as the ability to troubleshoot and do minor repairs. We may consider a highly qualified single candidate, however a mature, married couple with overseas living experience is preferred in this culture/context.

Specific responsibilities: Listed below are the minimum responsibilities that will normally fall specifically to Youth & Music Leader. The Youth & Music Leader will be under the direct supervision of the Sr. Pastor and accountable to the elders. His performance will be reviewed by the Sr. Pastor on an annual basis and reported to the congregation at a regular business meeting.

Specific Tasks:

- Organize the weekly youth meeting composed of worship, teaching, music and activities.
- Lead the corporate teaching of scripture to the students each week.
- Recruit & equip interns, mature student or adult volunteers to lead in worship through music.
- Manage, develop theme & lead the annual youth retreat.
- Recruit & equip adult volunteers who will assist in the ministry and lead small groups.
- Provide small group leaders with direction, outcomes & curriculum.
- Create an academic year ministry calendar for all AIC Student Ministry events.
- Maintain communication with students regarding events via Facebook and email.
- Visit each school where students attend at least once a semester. Develop relationships with the principal's and maintain occasional dialogue.
- Engage in one-on-one mentoring, counseling, and encouragement when needed.
- Pray regularly for the students, their parents and un-churched/nominal Christians.

Salary/Remuneration: The Student Ministry Leader of AIC has always been self-supporting. The financial history of AIC has never sufficiently provided for a full-time salary. A small stipend/donation to the Student Minister support fund is available in the budget but may only cover 15-20% of an ordinary modest budget, excluding dependent's school tuition. The Student Minister will be given 2 months sabbatical annually in summer to learn language, fundraise, travel, etc.
