

I give my child or ward permission to attend Euroventure. I have read the rules and realize that if he/she behaves in an unacceptable manner, dismissal at my expense might result. I have reviewed these rules with my child or ward and he/she agrees to abide by them.

EUROVENTURE EXPECTATIONS

We know that this is going to be an amazing week together. To ensure that, here are some important expectations for everyone:

1. Be present! Students must be on time and attend all sessions, from beginning to the end. We planned everything with you in mind so we don't want you to miss anything!
2. Be a great roommate! Keep the space clean and your things picked up. Students must be in the rooms and have lights out at the assigned times. This helps everyone sleep better!
3. Be healthy! Drugs, alcohol, any form of tobacco, firearms, weapons, or any fireworks are not permitted. Students possessing these at Euroventure will have their parents contacted and may be sent home at the discretion of the camp leadership. Energy drinks will not be allowed at camp. We discourage the consumption of energy drinks during the week of camp because they aren't good for your body and too many could prove dangerous!
4. Be distraction free! Electronic entertainment devices including phones are not allowed to be used during the week. All electronic devices should be turned into an adult leader who will lock them up for the week. We want you to really engage with the people and the environment.
5. Be appropriately dressed at all times! Please avoid short shorts and bare midriffs. Modest one-piece bathing suits only at the pool please. T-shirts are not allowed in the pool. Swimming trunks are required. No Speedos guys!
6. Be appropriate with your actions and where you go! Your public or private displays of affection with those you're attracted to are not appropriate for camp, so please save those for back home! Under no circumstances should you be on the hallway in the chalet of the opposite sex.
7. Be safe! Students who are injured or ill should contact the IBC Team or an adult leader immediately so that we can help you. Do not throw anything from the balcony or jump from the balcony. Do not get into any moving water (stream, river, etc.) unless this is a part of an organized camp activity. We want to get you back home in one piece!
8. Be a good representative! Because the facilities we use in Lenk hold our camp responsible for all damages, you, your family and your church are responsible for damages you cause to facilities. In the case of room damage and no admission of guilt, each person in the room will be billed an equal portion of the cost of repair by the church. We want to leave everyone in Lenk with a great impression of Euroventure!

I give permission that my child's or ward's photo or video may be taken for the IBC website, social media, and/or publication. Should I not wish his/her photo to be published, I will have my child or ward notify his/her adult sponsor as well as identify himself/herself to the registration desk at check-in on Saturday.

My child or ward has my permission to be in all Euroventure activities at the place named herein and on the dates named herein, except as noted by me. If a medical emergency should arise while my child or ward is at Euroventure or in transit to Euroventure and I cannot be reached, I consent and give my permission to the trip director or representative of Euroventure to select a physician and/or hospital for my child's or ward's care. I also give the physician and/or hospital, as selected by the trip director or representative of Euroventure, my permission to hospitalize, treat, give x-rays, tests and to order injections, anesthesia, or surgery for my child or ward, which may be in their sole discretion under the circumstances. I do release, acquit, discharge and covenant to hold harmless the church, the International Baptist Convention, its representatives, the trip director or Euroventure staff, of any and all actions, damages, or liabilities arising out of the treatment of any sickness or accident incurred by my child or ward to disclose any information there acquired, if requested. I understand that in the event of a medical emergency requiring medical care, all costs for such emergency care ARE MY RESPONSIBILITY and I agree to make payment of all such medical costs. I understand that I will be notified of medical care, and that I must notify my insurance carrier.
